### ***6/20-6/24: Forests***

### ***7/4-7/8: Rainforests***

### ***7/11-7/15: Desert***

We'll investigate cacti and sand that make up the desert. We'll discover the beauty of this arid environment and secrets of survival as we convoy through on Magic Camp dune buggies.



### ***7/18-7/22: Desert Animals***

This week, we will ponder questions such as; why do they live in the dry desert? How do they get water? We will caravan on camels as we explore the creatures that live here.

### ***7/25-7/29: Water Exploration***

Why do some water creatures not live in the ocean? We will snorkel into fresh water, brackish water, and salt water, as we learn about the unique uses for different bodies of water.

### ***8/1-8/5: Ocean***

What does the Ocean do for us? How do we preserve it? We will scuba under the ocean water as we explore the far reaching seas.



### ***8/8-8/12: Ocean Animals***

We will analyze the animals in the ocean as we dive below the sea. What do we see, are there just fish or is there more?
